Fuel Injector Cleaner???

A frequently asked question on the AutoLine program is: “Do you recommend the use of fuel injector cleaners or fuel additives?” The only fuel treatment we recommend for the do it yourselfer is the use of Chevron Techron. Techron can be found in most all auto parts stores in the fluids section. I recommend a Techron treatment once a year. I only recommend Techron because other cleaners can be too aggressive and actually cause damage to the injectors if not used properly. The Techron process is fairly straight forward and easy to perform.

1. Go to your auto parts retailer and purchase 2 bottles of Chevron Techron.
2. Run your fuel tank down to just below $\frac{1}{4}$ tank.
3. At the gas station add 1 full bottle of Techron to your tank and fill up with premium fuel.
4. Run that tank of premium fuel down to a $\frac{1}{4}$ tank.
5. Fill up again with a second full tank of premium, with NO Techron.
6. Let the second tank of premium fuel run down to a $\frac{1}{4}$ tank.
7. Now add the second full bottle of Techron to your tank along with a third tank of premium fuel.
8. Let the third tank run down to about $\frac{1}{4}$ tank to get the full strength of the Techron past the injectors before filling up again.

You will most likely notice an improvement in performance and fuel economy. Techron can also be found in Chevron and Texaco fuel, however we do not have many of these stations in the Cincinnati area. So the next best thing is to do your own Techron treatment.
